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What are the characteristics that a young person who will receive youth leadership training should have as a result of this meeting?

The characteristics that a young person who will receive youth leadership training should generally have are as follows:

1. Communication Skills

Ability to express oneself clearly and effectively

Active listening skills

2. Empathy and Sensitivity

Understanding and respecting the feelings of others

Being open to different perspectives

3. Teamwork

Ability to cooperate within a group

Ability to assume various roles

4. Problem Solving Ability

Dealing with challenges and developing creative solutions Critical thinking skills 5. Self-Confidence

Willingness to take risks
6. Cultural Awareness
Respecting different cultures and traditions
Being informed about global issues
7. Social Responsibility
Sensitivity to social problems
Desire to create change
8. Flexibility and Adaptability
Ability to adapt to changing conditions
Ability to adapt quickly to new situations
9. Self-Motivation
Determination to determine one's own goals and achieve them
Ability to work with intrinsic motivation

10. Leadership Potential Ability to influence and lead others Ability to solve problems and inspire

1. Youth Leadership Fundamentals

2. Communication Skills

Contribution: Young people have the opportunity to develop a desire to contribute to society and develop activism skills.

7. Cultural Awareness and Empathy

Importance: Cultural diversity is an important part of effective leadership.

Contribution: Young people develop the ability to understand and respect different cultures, becoming more inclusive leaders.

8. Self-Leadership

Importance: Setting their own goals and providing motivation are key elements of successful leadership.

Contribution: Young people gain self-discipline and motivation by focusing on their personal development.

9. Sustainability and Environmental Awareness

Importance: Promotes sustainable lifestyles.

Contribution: Young people make more conscious decisions by developing sensitivity to environmental issues.

10. Digital Leadership

Importance: Provides an opportunity to understand the requirements of leadership in the digital age.

Contribution: Young people can reach wider audiences by gaining skills to use social media and digital platforms effectively.
